



HARRIS COUNTY CONSTABLE PCT. 5 DEPARTMENT PROGRAMS

The Citizens Police Academy: The Academy is an 11 week program giving participants a view of law enforcement from the perspective of the officer patrolling the streets. Classes are held one night a week for 3 hours, and are comprised of classroom instruction combined with hands on experiences that in some cases are identical to the training our deputies experience.

The Teen Police Academy: Similar to the Citizens Police Academy but with an emphasis on teen related issues such as alcohol and DWI, narcotics and School District Police interaction.

R.A.D. Women's Self Defense: Equips women with the knowledge and skills needed to effectively deal with an aggressor. The class is 3 hours, held one night a week for 4 weeks.

Home/Business Inspection: A certified Crime Prevention Specialist will provide a thorough evaluation of your home, business, school, or religious facility, and offer suggestions on improving its security

Child Safety Seats: Precinct 5 provides families with assistance in making sure their children are in the appropriate safety seat, as well as instruction on proper installation.

Stranger Danger: A deputy will come to your children's school or day care and speak about the dangers of interacting with strangers. Approx. 1 hr. program designed for children ages 5-10.

Hero Read: A deputy will come to your children's school or day care and read aloud to their class. Approx. 1 hr. program aimed at children 2-6 years of age.

Scouting Merit Badge: A deputy is paired with your troop to instruct and assist them in earning specific merit badges. Approx. 1 hr. program for Cub, Boy, and Girl Scouts.

McGruff the Crime Dog: McGruff the Crime Dog is always ready to take a bite out of crime by visiting children in their schools or scheduled functions.

Computer and Gaming Safety: Helping youth recognize and deal with potential harmful issues while online, including cyber bullying. 1 hour program for ages 7-17.

Social Media Safety: Focuses on navigating popular social media sites while maintaining a high level of personal safety, including tips on protecting personal information. 1hr. program for all teens.

Preventing Bullying and Cyber Bullying: This program focuses on tactics for dealing with bullies, knowing when teasing crosses the line, when and how to report bullying. 1 program for ages 7-17.

Teen Personal Safety: Learn how a criminal thinks and how to become less of a victim. This is a 1 hr. program for teens. There is also a specific class for preteen and teen girls

Adult Personal Safety: This program covers how to keep yourself and your family safe while at home or away. F1 hour program for adults of all ages.

Citizen's Response to an Active Shooter:

It's one of the most dangerous, intense, and life changing events a person can encounter. Pct. 5 offers a class to better equip citizens, organizations, and employers to deal with an active shooter situation in the best ways possible.

Senior Safety: Similar to the Personal safety program but with a special emphasis on senior issues. 1 hr. program for adults 60 and above, and/or their adult relatives.

Identity Theft and Cyber Safety: Learn how to protect your identity and accounts, both on and off line. 1hr. program for adults of all ages.

Work Place, Religious Facility, School & Day Care Safety: Instruction in preventing, minimizing and surviving work place violence. 2 hr. program for businesses of all sizes.

Holidays & Shopping Safety: Tips for shopping in safety, securing your belongings and early recognition of threats. 1 hr. program for adults of all ages.

Neighborhood Crime Watch: Aimed at increasing safety and awareness within a neighborhood by assisting in starting and maintaining an organized Neighborhood Crime Watch. 1 hr. Program

Operation ID: Pct. 5 has engravers for you to mark your personal items with an identifying mark, (DL number, initials, etc.). If an item is stolen, it's then easier to identify, return and prosecute the violator.
